Dental Clinic

The East Grampians Dental Clinic is funded under Dental Health Services Victoria. This clinic is publically funded. East Grampians Dental Clinic provides emergency, general and denture treatments to all ages.

When will I be seen?

Due to demand, adults who require a check-up will be placed on a waiting list. We aim to provide general oral care to patients including examinations and treatment every 24 months.

Priority programs exist where patients receive treatments at the next available appointment.

Reception staff will be able to advise you an estimate of current waiting times for general, denture and priority care.

What about emergency care?

If you need emergency care contact reception and you will be assessed and if available a single appointment will be arranged to relieve your pain.

How much does it cost?

No charge for:

- children aged between 0-12 years
- teenagers 13-17 years with a health care card or receiving Family Tax Benefit Part A

Adults will be charged a co-payment fee of \$26.50 (minimum) and a maximum charge of \$106*. (*does not include the cost of dentures)

A \$26.50 flat rate applies to emergency treatment.

The maximum cost for dentures is \$129 for a full upper and lower acrylic denture.

You will need to discuss fees if you need specialist care prior to commencing treatment.
