Student Orientation Day

Parking

- <u>Strictly no parking in main hospital car park</u>
- Recommended parking is the Lowe St parking lot (entry off Basham St).
- ✓ Students who will be staying in 83 or 85 Queen St accommodation can park their vehicles in Lowe St or Queen St (at least 5 metres from the corner) until further advised during orientation.

Student Debrief Session/s

- ✓ Weekly group debrief sessions (Friday 14:00hrs 15:00hrs)
- Private debrief can be arranged if required. As per EGHS and your Education Providers Guidelines.

EGHS: Clinical Placement Expectations

Professional Behaviour

- Students are expected to display a professional manner at all times.
- ✓ Respect the culture, rights and dignity of others.
- ✓ Ask for clarification if unsure.
- ✓ Maintain confidentiality at all times.
- ✓ EGHS is a smoke free environment.
- ✓ All students staying in our Student Accommodation MUST ADHERE to the Deakin Rural Health and EGHS guidelines and policies.
- ✓ <u>DO NOT TAKE HANDOVER SHEETS OR</u> <u>PATIENT INFORMATION/DOCUMENTATION</u> <u>OUT OF THE BUILDING AT ANY TIME.</u>

Shifts and Rosters

- EGHS is unable to accommodate student roster swaps/changes to cater for students traveling home long distances after completion of their final shift. So please, forward plan your travel/accommodation if your final shift has you finishing at 21:30hrs.
- ✓ Roster changes must be negotiated with Clinical Teachers.
- ✓ Students are expected to be available for all rostered shifts across a 7 day roster (This will depend on the area you are placed in).
- Please, be 15 minutes early for your shift. This will display your interest in you placement and also employability prospects, if looking for a position at EGHS in the future.









Sick Leave

IF UNWELL PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND PLACEMENT

- ✓ Phone clinical area prior to the commencement of your shift and speak to a staff member.
- Advise the clinical teacher by email include full name, university/provider and current clinical placement area or leave a message via 5352 9589
- ✓ Gastroenteritis: Student can return 48 hours post last symptom.
- Respiratory illness: Student can return when symptoms albeit, a post a negative COVID-19 swab is completed and the Clinical Teacher is aware of result.

Social Media

- ✓ Any comments or photographic material posted to social media regarding EGHS whilst on placement may be considered a breach of confidentiality.
- ✓ If a breach occurs placement may be cancelled.

Mobile phones/ Smart Watches

STRICTLY NO MOBILE PHONES ARE:

 ✓ To be carried on your person, during your shift/s. (They may be utilised during breaks).

In-line with infection control policy SOP 70.18 wrist watches are not allowed:

 ✓ Wrist watches and bracelets are NOT to be worn whilst in a Clinical Environment/s completing Clinical Care.

Uniform Policy as per your Education Providers Clinical Guidelines:

- Footwear MUST BE BLACK/NAVY non-slip enclosed shoes.
- ✓ STRICTLY NO coloured runners/sneakers
- ✓ Uniform must be clean and ironed.
- ✓ Student ID must be visible.
- ✓ NO SLEEVES BELOW ELBOWS IN CLINICAL AREAS.
- ✓ Nursing watch with second hand required.
- ✓ A flat wedding band or like is permitted. Sleepers or studs for earrings are acceptable.
- Nails must be short, clean and natural without nail polish/shellac or acrylic.
- Head attire for example head scarf/hijab or turban may be worn for religious reasons: natural plain colours are recommended.

Documentation

- Prior to entering notes into a patient record students must draft a copy and preceptors must review and approve.
- Preceptors must counter sign all documentation.
- Students are required to print name, sign, designation (student nurse and education provider), date and time).

Student complaints process

- Consult and document issue with clinical teacher.
- ✓ Contact your Education provider.

Placement Assessments

- It is the responsibility of each student to know and understand their assessment documentation requirements, PRIOR to commencement of their placement.
- ✓ FORMATIVE and SUMMATIVE reports will be completed by the Clinical Teacher/Educator.
